## BRUISES ON THE SOUL: HEALING FOR THE ABUSED, HOPELESS AND HELPLESS

taught by Gregg Moder, Patten University

Kids today are flipping out silently. They are dealing with more problems of abuse that they can define. This workshop will begin with an overview of abuse in its various forms, and share how and when youth workers should intervene. This workshop will also give you skills to help students navigate the pain abuse leaves in its path. The goal is to help you learn how to help kids move from resting in the numbness of abuse to finding a greater life in the Kingdom.

## WHEN THE MEN ARE MIA (MISSING IN ACTION)

taught by Angie Ibarra, City Team Ministries San Francisco

Nationwide 60% of children in the city are growing up with female heads of households without a father present (in some cities it's as high as 77%). This workshop will equip you to assist those affected by fatherlessness in a holistic way. We will explore fatherlessness from a multidimensional angle: Who does it affect and how? How can we work together as a community of believers to address the issue?

## "SEX ON / SEX OFF": THE WHY AND HOW OF PURITY

taught by Heather Starnes, For Youth By Youth, Inc.

Everything about the age that we live in is saturated with sex. Teens are looking at sexual images on their cell phones through the midnight hours in the comfort of their bedroom. The opportunity to see or engage in sex is just like flicking an on/off switch. It can be difficult for our youth to understand 1) What purity is; 2) Why purity is a good idea; and 3) How to be pure. This workshop will equip the attendee with practical tools, scriptures & activities that can be used to teach students how to protect their body, mind and soul.

## LET THE ROOTS GO DEEP: GETTING TO THE HEART OF YOUR STUDENTS

taught by Dwight "TRANSPARENT" Taylor Sr. - L.I.F.E.style Ministries

Urban youth are more diverse and deal with more life issues than ever before. It can feel like all we are seeing are students who act out in the form of poor choices and difficult behavior. Yet, we are not looking for merely a change in actions, we long for true renovation of the heart. This foundational workshop will help you with practical tools to walk out life with your youth. Once you have set up programs, how do you relate? Then we will introduce the ICE principle (instruct, consequences, execution), as a discipline you can use with your youth to build solid relationships with healthy boundaries that lead to transformation, and move the hearts of youth into the depths of the arms of Christ.

## MOVING STUDENTS FROM SALVATION TO LORDSHIP: YOUTH WORKSHOP

taught by Kirk Davis, San Francisco Southeast Young Life & Corey Rose, Hilltop Community Church

One minute you're led by the lyrics of an Artist...the next minute you're led by a Facebook holla...then it's a friend, a bully, or anyone who will give you some attention! But what if you were a teenager being led by a King? What if you had treasure of your own, and not borrowed from a music video? In this session, you will have the opportunity to better understand the concepts of kings and kingdoms. We have seen counterfeiters (warlords, gang leaders and religious hierarchies). The goal of our time together is to reintroduce the concept of a king, his kingdom and what it means to be a royal subject and heir to the throne. Come and learn how to be a teenage leader through interactive learning, group discussion, investigation, role-play.

- Understanding predatory lending schemes
- How money circulates in urban communities
- Race, class, and power structures in our society
- How goal setting and decisions affect your future
- The benefits of delayed vs. instant gratification

This whole-person approach to financial literacy, called Life Economics, is built to give students the tools to succeed in an economic system that a significant portion of youth is unprepared to navigate. FutureProfits empowers students with the tools to break the chains of poverty, giving them the resources to determine their destiny and impact their community.
