# WORKSHOPS

## [101] Transforming Your Youth Ministry Overnight

taught by Brian Wade, New Life Community Church - Bowie, MD  
Everyone who works with youth in the city longs to see them transformed into vibrant followers of Christ. We would all like to believe that there is one, bottled "formula" to make this happen. Christ however, sees, each heart and wants to meet that person at their point of need. There are some practical tips, however, that can help to bring your ministry along to help see this happen. In this session we will be exploring some different elements to bringing transformation to your ministry through learning to meet young people from the city where they are.

## [101] Reaching High-Risk Youth

taught by Lisa Maynor, Cornerstone Peaceful Bible Baptist Church - Upper Marlboro, MD  
One in four youth are deemed at-risk of not developing into healthy adulthood. What works for the majority of kids in a youth ministry generally doesn't work with these kids. Can we offer them more than "three strikes and you're out?" Learn proven models of programming to effectively reach them with the Gospel.

## [201] Stress in the City: Beating Burnout in Urban Youth Ministry

taught by Joshua Smith, Celebration Church at Monroe St - Baltimore, MD  
This workshop takes an honest look at the stress, trauma, and burnout that come with living and ministering in the city. You'll leave with all sorts of practical, research-based tips to help you find your own personal and spiritual relief in the midst of pouring yourself into others. Learn how to move from stress in the city to resting in the Kingdom.

## [201] Prophetic Youth Ministry: A Holistic Model for the Urban Context

taught by LeVar Jones, Infinity Church - Baltimore, MD  
Based on the work of Fernando Arzola Jr. in his book, *Toward a Prophetic Youth Ministry: Theory and Praxis in Urban Context*, this biblically-based, holistic model for urban youth ministry flows out of the conversation between Jesus and an expert of the law where Jesus answered him, "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength and with all your mind"; and, "Love your neighbor as yourself."

## [301] Youth Ministry = Team Ministry: Keys to Building Local Youth Events and Regional Coalitions

taught by Jack Redmond, Christ Church - Montclair, NJ  
Building a strong local youth ministry requires a team of powerful servant leaders. These leaders can work together to build an ongoing life changing youth experience both within a local church/organization, or involving several local ministries. Learn principles on planning and organizing a one-time event, ongoing service, or even a coalition between youth programs to work together to influence a city.

## [301] Nurturing the Spark: Youth Spiritual Development

taught by Fred Oduyoye, Urban Youth Workers Institute - Cincinnati, OH  
Spiritual development is, in part, a constant, ongoing, dynamic, and sometimes difficult interplay between three core spiritual components: awareness and awakening, connecting and belonging, and a way of life. This workshop will take a look at these spiritual components discovered from three years of Search Institute's research. It will also challenge you to see how each component can help build a youth ministry that is about developing kids spiritually and not having them just entertained.

## [401] Youth-Adult Partnerships: Mobilizing Your Youth as Agents of Change (2-Part)

taught by Ray Nelson, World Vision - Washington, DC  
This foundational training describes our approach to transformational development where the role of children and youth is paramount-both as beneficiaries and as change agents in the development around them. Learn how to build youth programming in the context of community, while your teen leaders are simultaneously discussing the "value" of community impact.

## Teen Leadership Track (for high school students only)

As you envision and develop the emerging young leaders around you, think about bringing your TOP high school student leaders for a deeper leadership training experience designed just for them.

## Jumping Hurdles: How to Develop a Closer Relationship with God in the Midst of Life's Hurdles

taught by Phill Deal and Brandon Hite, New Bethlehem Baptist Church - Baltimore, MD  
Life is fast paced and sometimes seems to be non-stop; between school, after-school activities, home, work, friends, and other stuff - it just keeps going. However, we know that in order to be truly productive, we need to have a great relationship with God to keep us going on the right path. You could say life for you is like running in a hurdle competition, with the goal of finishing the way the coach (God) wants you to finish.
